Your petition must be legibly handwritten or typed and must be signed by you under penalty of perjury.

Read the entire form first before answering any questions.

Complete all applicable questions in the proper blank spaces. If additional space is required, you may finish answers to particular questions on the reverse side of the page or on an extra blank page. Make clear the question to which any such continued answer refers.

Set forth your answers concisely. You will note that brief explanatory comments appear throughout the form. Read these carefully before you answer the questions because they are intended to help you fill out the petition.

Only one sentence or conviction may be challenged in a single petition. If you challenge more than one, you must do so by separate petitions.

Every petition must be made under penalty of perjury. Any false statement of a material fact may serve as the basis for prosecution and conviction for perjury. You should be very sure that all answers are true and correct.

If you are seeking leave to proceed in forma pauperis (without paying the \$5.00 filling fee and other court costs), then you must also execute the affidavit on page seven, setting forth information which shows your inability to pay the fees and costs of the proceedings.

Petitions which are not prepared in accordance with these instructions will be returned.

When the petition is completed you should mail the <u>original</u> and two copies to the Clerk of the United States District Court for the Northern District of California, 450 Golden Gate Avenue, Box 36060, San Francisco, California 94102.

When and Where to File

Name

You should file in the Northern District if you were convicted and sentenced in one of these counties: Alameda, Contra Costa, Del Norte, Humboldt, Lake, Marin, Mendocino, Monterey, Napa, San Benito, Santa Clara, Santa Cruz, San Francisco, San Mateo and Sonoma.

If you file in the Northern District because you are now in a prison in this District but you were not convicted and sentenced in one of the above-named fifteen counties, your petition will likely be transferred to the United States District Court in which is located the State court which convicted and sentenced you. The Federal District Courts in California prefer that a petition should be considered in the district of conviction and sentencing. The records can be more easily consulted and witnesses are available if a hearing is necessary.

If you were not convicted and sentenced and are not now in a prison in the Northern District, do not file in this District. If you do, your petition will be denied for lack of jurisdiction of the subject matter and you will have to refile in the district of sentencing.

Who To Name As Respondent

You must name the person in whose actual custody you are. This usually means the warden or jailor. Do not name the State of California, a city, a county, or the superior court of the county in which you are imprisoned or by whom you were convicted and sentenced. These are not proper respondents.

If you are not presently in custody pursuant to the State judgment against which you seek relief but may be subject to such custody in the future (e.g. detainers), you must name the person in whose custody you are now and the attorney general of the State in which the judgment which you seek to attack was entered.
