

GENERAL ORDER NO. 21

COURT REPORTER SERVICES IN EXPEDITED

DAILY AND HOURLY COPY CASES

It appearing to the Court:

1. That the purpose of the enhanced transcript fees allowed to official court reporters for expedited, daily and hourly transcripts pursuant to General Order No. 13 is to underwrite the cost of the services of additional reporters;

2. That the provision of such extra services solely by official court reporters, can and frequently does cause additional cost to the United States because of the need to provide outside contract reporter services for magistrates;

IT IS ORDERED,

1. That necessary replacement reporter services arising from daily, expedited or hourly copy cases will be provided by, and at the expense of, the official court reporter responsible for the daily, expedited or hourly copy case, and such expense shall not be passed on to parties ordering transcripts.

2. That contract reporters paid by the United States will not be used to provide such replacement services.
